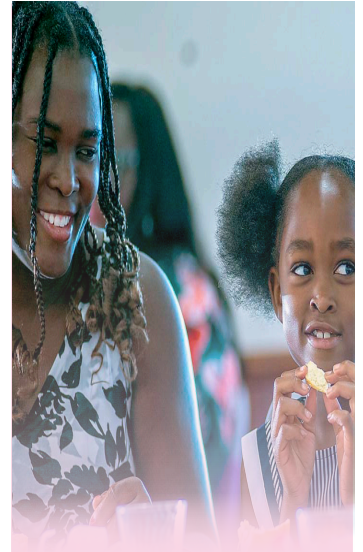

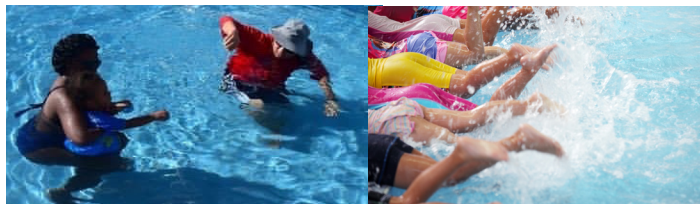

**TURTLE NESTING** Season runs from March 1 to October 31. There are five species of sea turtles in Florida, the Loggerhead being the most common. Florida beaches are home to 80% of Loggerhead turtles in the U.S. Turtles can migrate thousands of miles, but usually return to lay their eggs on the same beach where they hatched. Females usually lay several clutches of eggs per season. It is estimated that less than 1 of 1,000 hatchlings will survive to adulthood. Sea turtles live their entire life in the ocean, with the female only coming ashore to lay eggs.

If you live near the beach, you can help by keeping outside lights off during turtle season and allowing dune vegetation such as sea grapes to grow and block the light. Make sure to remove chairs, umbrellas and other gear from the beach each night. Level all sand castles and fill any holes dug during play, and pick up all trash. Sea turtles mistakenly eat debris, especially plastic, which results in death.

# PAVILION Reservations



The City of Boynton Beach Recreation and Parks Department offers park pavillion rentals at specified parks. The reservation is for the pavillion area only; the park itself is open to the public.

Reservations are required at least five days before your function and may be made up to six months in advance. Unreserved pavillions are available on first-come, first-served basis. \$100 deposit is required for all pavillion reservations.

- We recommend visiting the park to make sure that the pavilion and surrounding amenities meet your needs.

- Planning to have a bounce house? Patrons must use one of the pre-approved companies who have provided the City a copy of their insurance and have obtained all of the necessary licenses to operate in the City. A list of companies is available on the website. Bounce houses (maximum size 15'x15') are only permitted in conjunction with a pavillion reservation and not permitted at Oceanfront Park.

- No alcohol, animals, rides, waterslides, pools, amplified music, or fireworks are permitted. Electricity is not available.

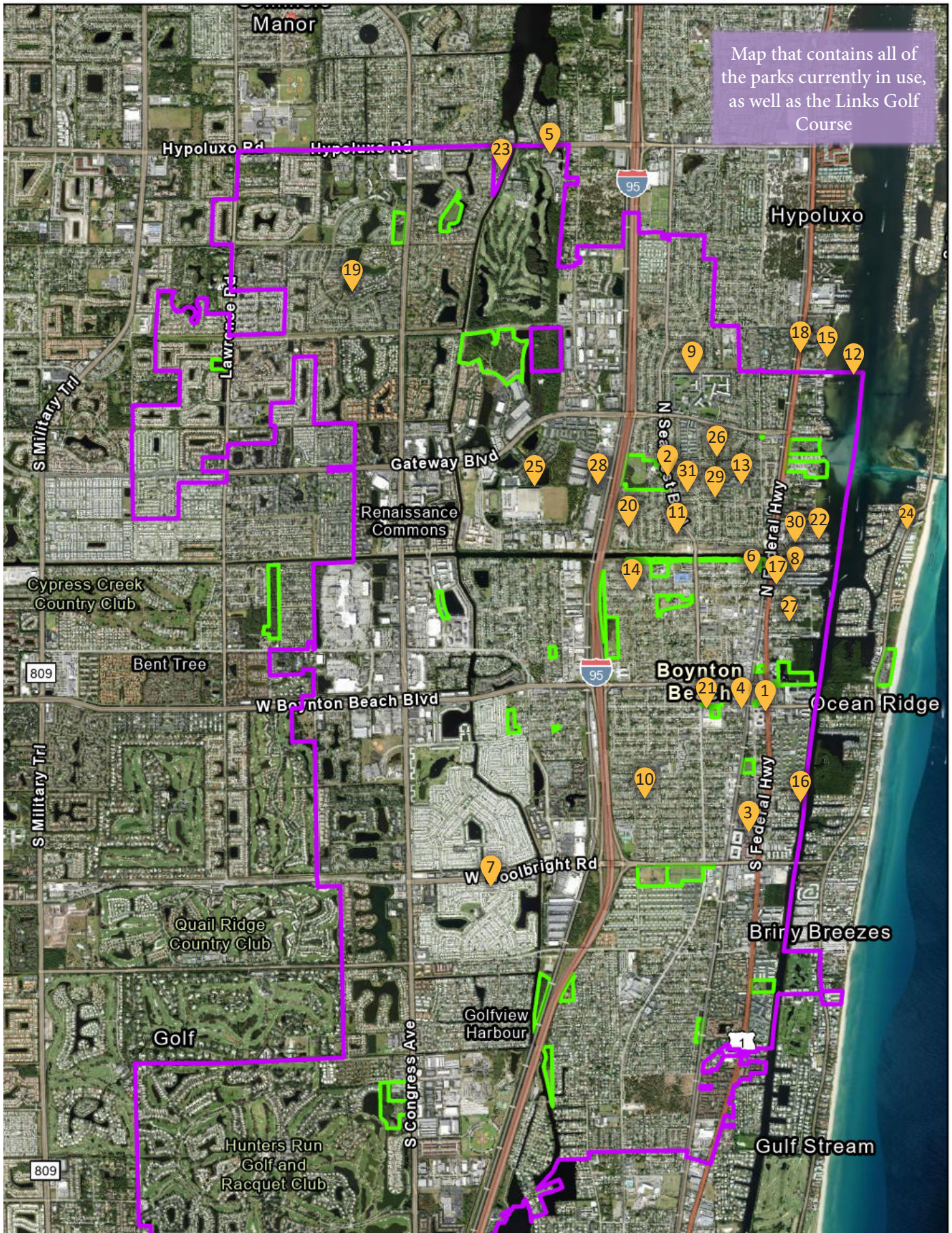

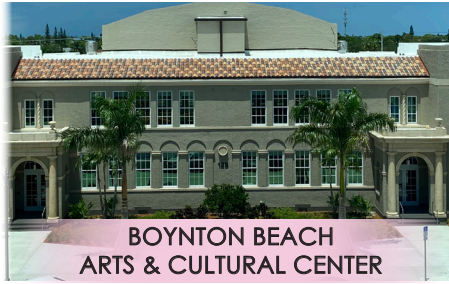

**AGE REQUIREMENT/BIRTH CERTIFICATES:** All youth participants must meet the age requirement by the start date of the class/program for which they are being enrolled (unless otherwise noted). A birth certificate may be requested as proof of age. To ensure the maximum benefit and enjoyment of recreational activities, the Recreation and Parks Department reserves the right to withdraw any participant who does not meet the age criteria.
