Turkin's Next Step

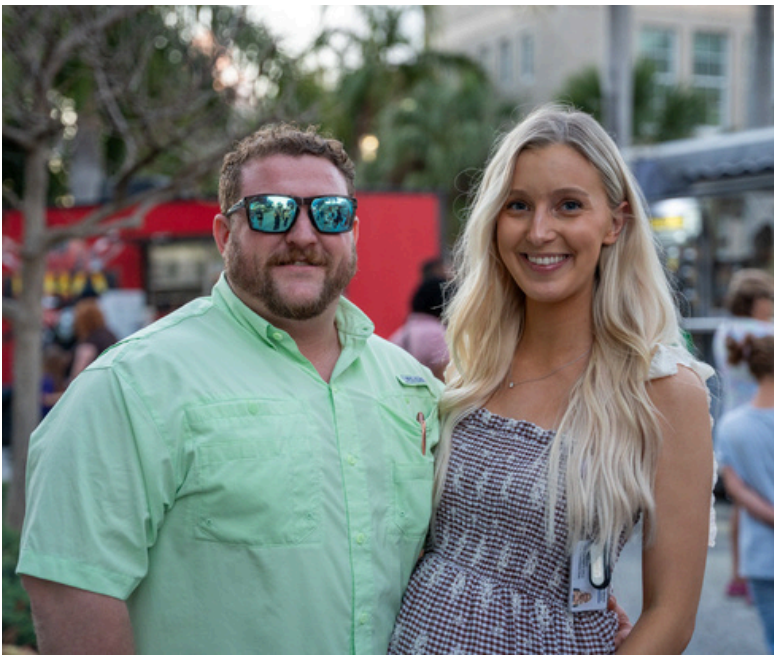
